The annual premium for a single student is \$1,344. Plans for student/spouse, student/family, and children are available as well.

We are also fortunate to have a physician and staff available five days a week at the University Health Services. We encourage all students to use this facility, as many services are free or offered at an extremely reduced rate; however, University Health Services only offers primary care. I am asking you to review whether or not you have extended coverage in the event of an illness or accident.

I encourage you as students and/or parents to ensure that some form of comprehensive medical insurance is attained. Many students are covered under a family plan, but I urge you to check carefully as you make your plans for attending the university. For those of you who participate in HMO's, please pay close attention to the rules and restrictions.
